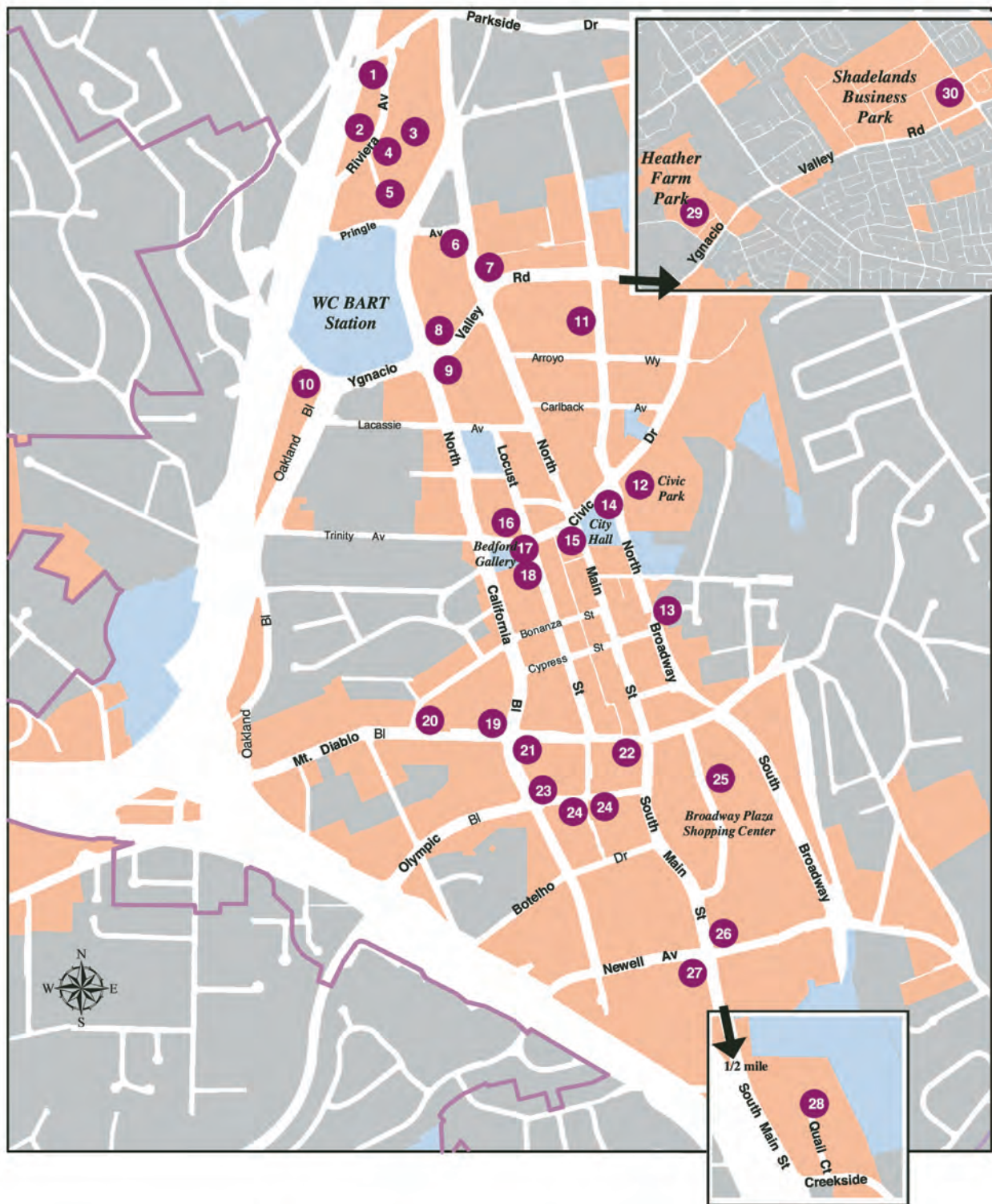


PUBLIC ART IN WALNUT CREEK WALKING TOUR
